9 resident here, and it's been my privilege to speak at a Nuclear

23 amuck, and of course we have two -- the Millennium coming up,  
24 which my head gear celebrates.

25                   We hope to get through that, and of course we  
  
1 can't ask -- don't solve all the problems of the world, but if  
2 they would alert the youth -- and I am one for the American  
3 spirit -- and let it triumph as it has in the past.

4                   So thanks very much, and that was just something  
5 I wanted to add to the occasion.
