1 MR. WALLIS: My name is Stan Wallis. I'm -- I'm  
2 a member of the Caliente City Council and also a member of the  
3 Joint City/County Alleviation Committee and I, too, would like  
4 to reiterate what Brian just said, and also the Draft EIS  
5 indicates that many new jobs will be created in Caliente area  
6 as a result of the intermodal activity.

7 The Draft EIS does not estimate how many  
8 additional residents will reside in our community as a result  
9 of this new employment opportunity.

10 The Final EIS should indicate and include the  
11 estimates and the number of new residents by age, how many --  
12 who will relocate in the Caliente area in addition to the Final  
13 EIS should give predictions on how many additional school  
14 children will be into our school system as a result of this  
15 impact, if any, and how many residents will have an additional  
16 impact on the infrastructure, sewer, water, electric, et  
17 cetera.

18 There's a number of issues that I know that this  
19 committee has looked at and I appreciate them coming here and  
20 giving us the opportunity to voice our comments, and thank you.
