Comments: I am an enthusiastic support of the Yucca Mountain Project. I live in Idaho and served as Idaho Governor Phil Batt's top aide on Idaho's nuclear waste clean up and removal agreement with the DOE and U.S. Navy. The federal court order Idaho and federal officials signed requires the federal government to remove its spent nuclear fuel and other wastes from Idaho. Yucca Mountain seems to me be the perfect site for the wastes now stored above Idaho's largest fresh water aquifer.
