I request that these comments be made a part of the official record.

1 What will be the worst case accident considered in the EIS and how will the effects be assessed?

2 How will transportation routes from reactors to Yucca Mountain be evaluated? Will the EIS identify specific routes with available routing models or will DOE do a generic routing analysis?

3 Will the EIS evaluate the results of radiation exposures to specific population centers along specific routes? For example, will you evaluate the effects of a worst case accident on conditions in specific metropolitan areas and specific rural areas along specific transportation routes?

4 How will DOE bound the number of shipments required to move waste from reactors to Yucca Mountain? Does the EIS assume that new, large rail and truck casks will be available and are these new casks realistic given the costs involved and the fact that DOE is now prohibited from engaging in cask design and production activities?
