1 I am a concerned citizen of the state of Utah writing regarding the proposed storage of nuclear waste on the Skull Valley Goshute/Shoshone Indian reservation. I oppose this proposed action because the company, PFS, has failed to consider important factors in their choice of locations. They have not considered the worst-case scenarios including military war games gone astray, seismic activity, poorly contained radioactive elements, and the long-term effects of spent fuel rods in open-air containment - prevailing winds which are sodium-based (Salt Flats??) Further, it is a heinous crime on the government's part to allow a company to deceive a native American tribe - one on the brink of extinction - for the company's convenience with no forethought for the tribe.
