Please accept this FAX as my comments on Yucca Mtn. DEIS.

I continue my previous comments. I add the following.

1 Although the Mobile Chernobyl bill passed the Senate yesterday, it did not pass with enough votes to override a presidential veto. The sponsors have stated that they do not plan to push this particular bill at this time due to the promise of a presidential veto to the bill in its present form. Without this Mobile Chernobyl bill, there is no reason for this DEIS at this time.

This DEIS unfairly and dangerously will cause the transportation of high level radioactive spent fuel in thousands of tons across this country to a site which still has not passed scientific muster. I request that this DEIS be discarded.
