Violates the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982.

- 1 • The fundamental concept of geological disposal as outlined in the act was for waste isolation. Instead the DEIS describes and "evolving" facility design based on delayed release of radioactivity by means of engineered barriers, so the site will leak. How much and when is not clear.

2 If how much radiation will leak is not clear; if when it will leak is not clear - then it's not clear when consideration for geological disposal of the nuclear waste should be considered. This is a call for a 3 year postponement of consideration, therefore.
