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ROY BYRAM: My name is Roy Byram. I have a small organization called the B2F3 ban burning fossil fuel forms. We are very enthusiastic about this Yucca Mountain repository, and we don't think that all this wasted time and site characterization should go on and be protected indefinitely.

Now, people talk about the geologic processes. I can't do anything, and you can't do anything about what mother nature did over the millennium. And they talk about the future. I can't talk about what's going to happen in the future because I don't know. I can only talk about right now.

Excuse me, I have COPD, and I only got one lung so occasionally I run out of wind.

I now want to talk about the theater of the absurd. I want to talk about the pimps of the dirty air lobby that are stalling this vitally necessary facility. And we're talking about the recent primary. Joe Neal ran against a bright young fellow by the name of Gary Clinton. Well, Clinton said he was against the repository. And I said, Clinton, get real. Now, this fellow Loo that spoke here, he calls himself Lo-ux. I call him the British Loo because the resemblance is very close. What he deals, he's supposed to be protecting the people in Nevada. He's protecting his pocket. I'm going to have the Attorney General file a -- I'm going to file formal proceedings against her and have her find out what he has done for the people in Nevada. He's a pimp for the dirty air lobby.

Okay. Now, we'll go to Reid. He is now the whip of the Senate, and he got no choice. He got to deliver the votes in the senate for the repository. So with all this talk, all this money, you got all these years, and saving the people, it's just going to go out the window. That's just your typical politician. Thank you.
