Comments: I have been listening to all of the debate about Yucca Mountain and I want to state for the record that my husband and I are very unhappy about the impending decision to use Nevada as the defenseless "dump" for the rest of the Country's Nuclear garbage!

I heard on the news tonight that the decision is ultimately "up to Congress and the government"... last I checked, the population of the entire state of Nevada provides with far less Congressional representation than most of the states who will "benefit" from using our home as a dump for unimaginably dangerous nuclear waste materials! There is absolutely no way that this waste site can ever be completely safe and utterly and completely free of any hazard to our water and other natural resources. It is simply not possible to safeguard the site in this manner and I have read the potential dangers to the current plans.
