Long term storage of spent nuclear fuel ceased to be a technical problem when current isolation and storage methods were developed over 30 years ago. Since then the issue has been delayed by baseless hysteria and politics. It is time to stop wasting money on studies and half finished projects and complete the Yucca Mountain project.

Nuclear utilities have kept their commitment to pay fees that will fund the burial site. The Federal Government has not kept the commitment to provide the site. If the intention is to keep delaying a permanent repository, then the fees should be returned to the utilities so that they may fund their own temporary spent fuel storage.
