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12 MR. HARRIS: Thank you. My name is George
13 Harris. My family's lived in this valley for 50 years.
14 And I'm a business guy here. Okay? And I'm so happy
15 you shared that information with me, because now I can
16 go out and tell the 250 FAMILY members, all my
17 employees and all the members, you know, you say it's
18 okay to bring nuclear waste here. Here's the reality,
19 okay? Perception's reality. All right? Pepcon,
20 Pepcon crippled this town for two weeks. If the
21 perception that a truck rolls over, nothing happens,
22 with the way the media works today, it goes all around
23 the world. And if you think I'm kidding you guys,
24 think about this: You can go to Europe now, for almost
25 \$300, 399 round trip. Because a mad cow disease has
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1 destroyed their tourism. Okay? It's, it's shameful.

2 All right?

3 I'm totally against nuclear waste. But I'll
4 tell you what, we're Nevadans. Shame on everybody in
5 this room for the way some of us have acted. We don't
6 have to -- I don't agree with this guy. But our issue
7 is right, we're on the right side of the issue. You

8 don't boo at people, and I mean, it's embarrassing.

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9 But I'll tell you, the disinformation on both sides is

10 -- you know, Harry Reid said today, on TV, you had to

11 go through three checkpoints to get here. That's just

12 not true. I drove right through -- I drove right to

13 the gate, right to the parking lot. We can't lose

14 credibility on the issue. Okay?

15 (APPLAUSE)

16 Don't -- don't sit and heckle. Don't say, if

17 it's not -- we can all stay here. All right? I got to

18 tell you guys, your credibility with me is a little

19 shot because you can't even keep this room cold. I

20 mean, you know, I am just -- I'm telling from you

21 perception. I represent my employees and my family.

22 And I've lived here all my life. All right? And

23 perception's reality, and you guys, I win.

24 I -- and I also want to say this. Don't

25 close your ears to everything either. Learn. I went

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1 to the nuclear waste repository thing two months when

2 they were into it. Okay? It was like a 10-foot hole.

3 All right? I have also got to say, you know what,

4 guys, I need to go back up there and look, because I

5 haven't taken the time to go back and look. But I can
6 tell you what, when it's all over and in, everybody
7 needs to stand in a line to make sure no one comes over
8 this border with nuclear waste. Because it's only
9 going to bring heartbreak to these families. Thank you
10 very much.

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
