I wish to voice my opinion that Secretary Abraham should recommend Yucca Mountain to the President as the site for the high level waste repository. I believe that the site has been sufficiently characterized and studied to conclude that it is suitable for this purpose, and will allow the safe storage of high level waste.

I consider nuclear power to be an essential part of our nation's energy supply. I have always considered it to be one of the most environmentally benign ways to produce electricity. In order for the nuclear option to remain viable in the long term, including the building of new nuclear units, we have to solve the waste disposal issue. Recommending the Yucca Mt. site as the repository is a critical step in that process.
