I have recently been made aware that the Yucca Mountain issue is finally at a point of being settled. I am requesting that the Department of Energy recommend to President George Bush to site the national repository for high-level radioactive waste and spent fuel at Yucca Mountain, Nevada.

For many years I have followed the effort spent on siting a national disposal facility. Now all of the credible evaluations are in. With all the risk factors considered, the storage of high-level radioactive waste at one location is a much better option than continuing to accumulate spent nuclear fuel at more than 70 sites throughout the nation.

I urge the Department to recommend the Yucca Mountain site to the President.
