20 I just wanted to know what all of you people
21 are? We're called "acceptable risks." We're the
22 acceptable risks if anything goes wrong. There must be
23 a big threat out there if there are so many acceptable
24 risks. This is, we're talking on just a local level,
25 Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada. This thing has a

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1 possibility of being a global problem, not just a local
2 problem.

3 I don't have faith in my government because
4 it's coming. I know that we got all these dog and pony
5 shows to show how we care about you, but it's coming.
6 All I can say is be prepared. There is not anything we
7 can do to stop them.

8 You know, it's like they said, we've seen the
9 enemy and it's ourselves. Well, we're looking at the
10 enemy. And like I said, I'd like to be more
11 optimistic, but I don't have that faith. It just isn't

12 there.

14 never seen the Federal Government not get its way.

15 That's just the way it is. And like I said, there is,
