I would like to see further research on how DOE of this railway will not obstruct wildlife, wild horses, & natural grazing allotments. For example, the train travels very close to water sources. The noise, construction, rail & others will sever natural migratory patterns for these animals. Many animals will not feel comfortable crossing this rail or going through a tunnel. Wild life & BLM Horse & Buckro specialists should be consulted & their concerns addressed.
